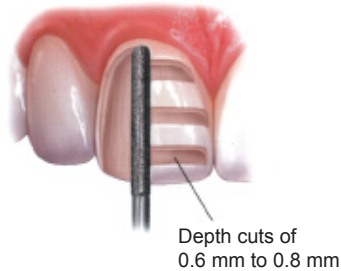


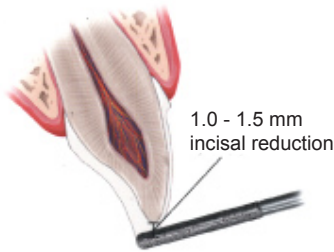
## VENEER PREPARATION

A medium grit, round-ended diamond bur is used to remove a uniform thickness of facial enamel by joining the depth-cut grooves.



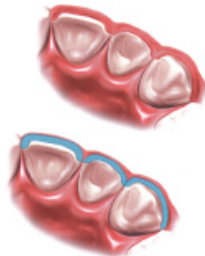
## INCISAL PREPARATION

The diamond bur is angled to bevel the incisal edge.



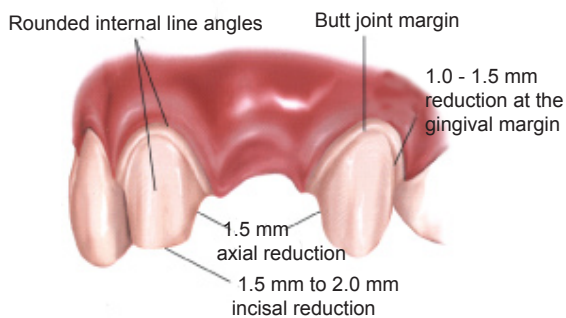
## CHAMFER MARGINS

Correct preparation of the chamfer margins interproximally allows the appropriate bulk of porcelain.

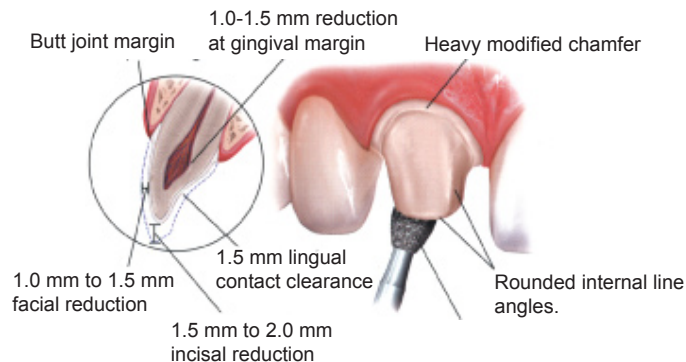


- When closing diastemas Inter proximal margins need to extend to lingual marginal ridges, eliminating any and all undercuts.
- Uniform facial preparation is recommended.

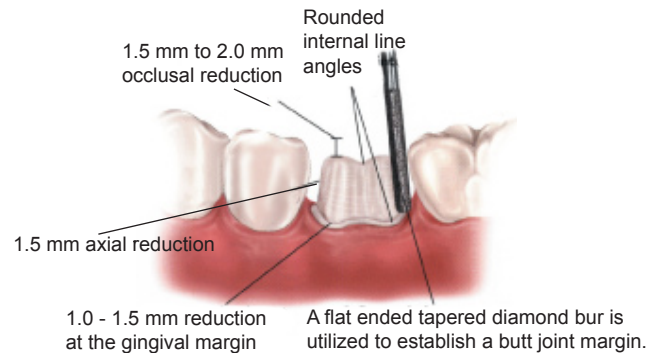

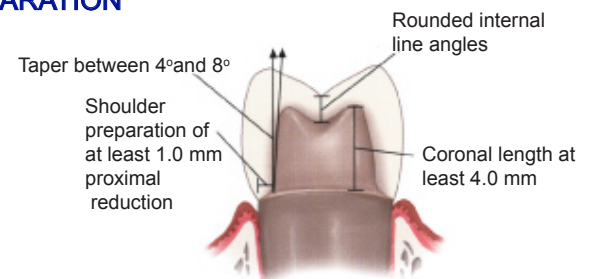
## ANTERIOR CROWN PREPARATION
